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
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


This is our **house** and **car**. **hwnax** (nok) **doodaxi** (thloo-daw-kee)




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
We store **food** in our **cache**. **c'aan** (kan) **'tsaa** (chaw) 4


We dry the salmon on our **fishrack** protected by our **dogs**. **daxi** (daw-kee) **-***lic'ae* (thlick-a) 7






Many other **people** live in our village **denaey** (den-nay) 9



We gather here for **potlatches**. **hwtiitl'** (koo-teeth) 10





This is where we go to **school**. **dats'ehwdeliizde** (na-dot-dell-dee-deh) 11




See the black raven on the store. It'uuts' (ell-toots) saghani (saw-gaw-nee)









See the mother **duck** and her baby swimming in the **lake**. **dats'eni** (dot-sen-nee) **ben** (ben)




The **eagle** eats the salmon swimming in the *river*. **sgoolak** (sgoo-lak) 'na (naw) 16




Caribou travel in the *hills* behind our village. udzih (you-jee) tes (tess) 17



The **fox** lives in a den. **nagget'si** (naw-get-see) 18





The **porcupine** has many sharp **quills**. **nuuni** (new-nee) **c'ox** (kee-oak) 20






Wild **white** sheep live high up in the mountains. ggay (guy-ee) 22





Ptarmigan eat berries. lacbeh (lok-beh) gigi (gih-gee) 25
